A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian passport.

Luggage

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you will need to carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the loading and unloading of luggage from the coach.

ITINERARY

MAY 21ST, 2026 (THURS) – DEPARTURE

Meet at Sydney International airport for your evening flight to Milan

MAY 22ND, 2026 (FRI) – MILAN / ARRIVAL

(-, -, D) Arrival in Milan and transfer to your accommodation and relax before dinner. Overnight in the hotel.

MAY 23RD, 2026 (SAT) – MILAN

(B, -, -) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Visit (with local guide) La Scala theatre, the Duomo, Milan Cathedral (entrance included) and Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, the oldest shopping mall in Europe. Free afternoon at leisure. Overnight in the hotel.

MAY 24TH, 2026 (SUN) – MILAN / COMO

(B, -, D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Travel to Como and enjoy a walking tour (with local guide) of the city. In the afternoon, free time in Como. Transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

MAY 25TH, 2026 (MON) – COMO / BELLAGIO / COMO (ferry boat)

(B, -, -) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. After breakfast at your hotel, we will travel to Bellagio by boat (ticket included) on Lake Como. Arrival in Bellagio and free time to stroll around this small village, known as the Pearl of Lake Como. Transfer back to Como by boat (ticket included). Overnight in the hotel.

MAY 26TH, 2026 (TUE) – COMO / LUGANO / COMO

(B, -, -) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Lugano to visit (with local guide) this town. We will enjoy a typical Tyrol lunch (not included in the price, on own expense). Back to Como for Overnight in the hotel.

MAY 27TH, 2026 (WED) – COMO / LAKE ISEO / BRESCIA

(B, -, D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Lake Iseo area, to have a wine tasting in

Franciacorta (included in the price). In the afternoon, transfer to your accommodation in Brescia. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

MAY 28TH, 2026 (THURS) - BRESCIA / BOLZANO

(B, -, D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Travel from Brescia to Bolzano. After arrival, free afternoon for personal activities. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

MAY 29TH, 2026 (FRI) – BOLZANO

(B, -, -) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. City tour of Bolzano (with local guide) including the Duomo and the South Tyrol Museum and see the iceman Ötzi (entrance included). Ötzi is the natural mummy of a man who lived between 3350 and 3105 BC. Ötzi's remains were discovered on 19 September 1991, in the Ötztal Alps (hence the nickname "Ötzi" at the Austria–Italy border. He is Europe's oldest known natural human mummy, offering an unprecedented view of Copper Age Europeans.

In the afternoon, we will have a wine tasting at a local winery (included in the price). Back to the hotel for overnight.

MAY 30TH, 2026 (SAT) – BOLZANO / BRESSANONE-BRIXEN / BOLZANO

(B, -, -) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Travel to visit (with local guide) the baroque town of Bressanone-Brixen, St Michael's Cathedral and Rodeneck Castle (all external visits). Back to Bolzano and overnight in the hotel.

MAY 31ST, 2026 (SUN) – BOLZANO / CORTINA D'AMPEZZO / BASSANO DEL GRAPPA

(B, -, D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Travel to Bassano del Grappa via Cortina. We'll have a stop in Cortina for some free time. Onto Bassano del Grappa for dinner and overnight.

JUN 1ST, 2026 (MON) – BASSANO DEL GRAPPA AREA

(B, -, -) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Morning city tour of Bassano del Grappa (with local guide), visiting the Museum of Grappa, botanic gardens,

ceramics factory and Villa Godi Malinverni (all external visits). Free afternoon. Back to the hotel for overnight.

JUN 2nd, 2026 (TUE) - TRENTO

(B,-,-) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Visit (with local guide) Trento, with the Buonconsiglio Castle (entrance included) and Santa Maria Maggiore Church and Geremia Palace (all external visits). Back to Bassano del Grappa for overnight in the hotel.

JUN 3rd, 2026 (WED) - BASSANO / MAROSTICA / VICENZA

(B,-,D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Travel to Vicenza via Marostica – famous for its ‘living’ chess event. Stop in Marostica. On to Vicenza. Arrival, check-in to accommodation and free afternoon. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

JUN 4th, 2026 (THURS) - VICENZA

(B,-,-) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Visit (with local guide) Vicenza, including the Olympic Theatre (entrance included) and Villa Contarini (entrance included). Free afternoon at leisure. Overnight in the hotel.

JUN 5th, 2026 (FRI) – VERONA

(B,-,-) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Visit (with local guide) Verona, including Juliette’s balcony (external visit). Afternoon free to explore the city. Back to Vicenza for overnight in the hotel.

JUN 6th, 2026 (SAT) – VICENZA / PADUA / VENICE

(B,-,D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Travel to Venice Mestre and stop in Padua to visit the 13th century St Anthony’s Basilica. On to Venice Mestre for dinner and overnight in the hotel.

JUN 7th, 2026 (SUN) – VENICE

(B,-,-) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Tronchetto pier to embark on the Vaporetto to Venice Island (ticket included). Enjoy a city tour (with local guide) of Venice: visiting Doges Palace,

Rialto Bridge, San Marks square (all external visits). Back to the hotel for overnight.

JUN 8th, 2026 (MON) –MURANO AND BURANO

(B,-,-) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Tronchetto pier to embark on the Vaporetto to Murano and Burano islands (ticket included). Full day visiting (with local guide) both the islands of Murano for its glassware and Burano for its lace work. Back to Venice Mestre for overnight in the hotel.

JUN 9th, 2026 (TUE) – VENICE / PARMA

(B,L,D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Parma and visit (with local guide) the Parmigiano Reggiano and the Prosciutto di Parma Factory (entrance included) including a light lunch (included in the price). Transfer to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

JUN 10th, 2026 (WED) – MODENA / MARANELLO

(B,-,D) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Modena to enjoy a balsamic vinegar tasting (included in the price). Then, transfer to Maranello to visit (with local guide) the Ferrari Museum (entrance included). Farewell dinner in the hotel and overnight.

JUN 11th, 2026 (THURS) – DEPARTURE

(B,-,-) Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Free time in the morning until the appropriate time for the transfer to Milan Malpensa International Airport for your return flight to Sydney.
